Grandstand: Best = TV Corner Sections - Parade Zone 1

Events: Equifest - Horse performers show

Floatfest - See Parade Floats up close - before or after Parade

June - Determine how Participants will get from Campground to Parade

We decided: Charter Motorcoach to and from Parade and carpool to other Events

Note: Don't lag on this: I didn't start until August - by then almost all Busses were gone

We used: Inland Empire: https://www.iesbuses.com/ - Cost = \$2,400.

Bus Parking Pass required: \$350

Collected \$100/Participant to cover bus & parking costs

Oct - Nov: Seating and Event Tickets get sent to Participants

Float Decorating: During the entire year, various Organizations design and build their Floats. For 2023, there were approx. 40 Floats in the Parade. During last 2 weeks before Parade (or more), the Organizations seek Volunteers to work decorating their Floats. Several of our Participants did Float decorating for one day on the Elks Float. Many of our RV Group Members are members of the Elks. All organizations need Volunteers for decorating.

Summary: Attending the Tournament of Roses Parade was a "Bucket-List" experience for almost all of our Participants I expected all 18 Sites would be taken early. That didn't happen. Club Members ultimately took 11 of our 18 Reserved Sites. 3 other Sites were taken by non-Club friends. The remaining 4 Sites were released back to Bonelli Bluffs in December.
